In the past 36 months, and anticipating the next 12, Dr. Shaneyfelt is an investigator on a grant awarded to the Birmingham VA Medical Center to study storytelling in the management of gout (no salary support). He has received a grant from the university health services foundation to develop an online course on EBM for the medical school (no salary support, funding only paid for web design and instructional design consultation). He has had travel reimbursed to speak at an international EBM meeting. He is a member of the National Comprehensive Cancer Center guideline panel on prostate cancer early detection and received travel reimbursement for panel meetings. He has been a member of the American College of Physicians Performance Measurement Committee and has received travel reimbursement.
