## Therapeutics

Wearing elastic compression stockings during long-haul flights prevented the development of deep venous thrombosis	169
No difference existed in developmental outcomes at 3 years of age between early or delayed tympanostomy for otitis media	170
Review: aspirin reduces the incidence of coronary artery disease in people at risk	171
Bucindolol reduced mortality and hospitalisation related to cardiovascular causes in advanced chronic heart failure	172
Carvedilol reduced mortality and hospitalisation in severe chronic heart failure	173
Stents had similar clinical outcomes but more repeated revascularisation than did bypass surgery in multivessel disease	174
